

Video and Hybrid Meeting Setup Guide



Preparation:

IMPORTANT: Testing Network/Firewall Configuration

Before you have a real video parents' evening, we highly recommend your IT team tests that teachers' computers/devices which will be using the school's network/firewall will not block the video meeting technology (called 'Twilio') which is employed by Parents Booking.



Create Video/Hybrid Parents' Evenings

- 1. Upload your school's "data" as per usual (see the <u>Admin Guide</u> if you need a reminder).
- 2. Set up your parents' evening like normal, but make sure you set the parents' evening is set to either 'Video Calls' or 'Hybrid', rather than 'In-Person'.

N.B If you select Hybrid meetings, each "day" or "block" of time you create will ask if these meetings will be video or in-person, so be sure to configure this correctly, as shown in the screenshot below.




3. Once your parents' evening has been set up, it is <u>crucial</u> that you set up logins for the teachers who will be involved with the parents' evening if you have not already. If the teachers cannot login, they cannot join their video calls.

Go to the Teachers page.

• If the teachers' emails are missing, you will need to type/paste them in and press 'Save Rooms/Emails' to save them and send teachers their username/passwords by email.

OR

If the teachers' emails are already saved, you can send teachers
who are marked as "Not Confirmed" their username/password
email by ticking their name (or using "Select All" to select all
teachers on the page you are viewing) and pressing "Email
Password Reset".




4. Once you have saved the teacher e-mails OR used the "Email Password Reset" button, the "Login Setup" column will change from "Not Configured" to "Password Sent".

"Password Sent" confirms that teachers have been sent an e-mail that asks them to choose a password, and instructions to login with. This password, combined with their work e-mail (which is their username), will allow them to login to www.parents-booking.co.uk.

Once logged in, teachers can check their appointment schedules and join their video meetings.

N.B. 20 teachers are shown per 'page', so repeat the above steps for all pages of teachers, until everyone has been sent their password.

5. We advise that you ask ALL teachers to make sure they can login to www.parents-booking.co.uk in advance of the parents' evening, to test they are able to login and can see their appointment schedule (by clicking the parents' evening name on their landing page). It is here, on the day of the parents' evening, that they will see a button to join their video meetings (which will look like the below).



- 6. You are now ready to send parents their invite to make video/hybrid parents' evening appointments. Furthermore, if teachers have been given permission to block out time or extend their schedules, they can do this. Everything is ready for parents to make video appointments, and for teachers to join those sessions from their login/Dashboard.
- 7. Participants (parents and teachers) must use a computer/smart device which has a webcam and microphone.

You must use one of the below device and internet browser combinations for the video meeting technology to work:

- Apple iPhone/iPad (must be iOS 11+): Safari or Chrome
 - (Chrome is only compatible in iOS 14.3+)
- Android phone/tablet: Chrome or Firefox
- Linux computer: Chrome or Firefox
- Microsoft Surface: Chrome or Firefox
- Mac PC: Safari (version 11+), Chrome or Firefox
- Windows PC: Chrome, Firefox or Edge
 - (To be specific, only the newer Edge 'Chromium' is compatible)
